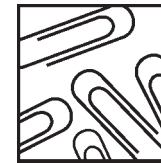

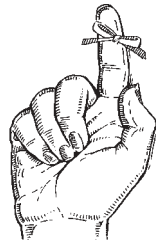
All MVP Volunteers
