



Job Description: Discipleship Pastor

Principal Function:

The Discipleship Pastor will have a passion to make disciples and to lead others to make disciples who are transformed by The Gospel, connected in Biblical community, and living out God's mission in their lives.

Responsibilities:

1. Lead church in planning, conducting, and evaluating a comprehensive program of Discipleship and Adult Education
2. Support current vision for Discipleship Groups (D Groups)
3. Identify, train and equip new leaders for the purpose of multiplication
4. Minister to and shepherd leaders, equipping them to better serve their groups
5. Lead the church to be aware of the educational and discipleship resources available and to choose what is most suitable
6. Create, implement, and oversee a plan to involve and integrate new Christians and new members into our church family, including Sunday School, Discipleship Groups and finding areas of service according to their gifts
7. Guide and communicate with Adult Ministry leaders, ensuring that these ministries are in line with Seymour FBC's overall discipleship strategy
8. Oversee and administer appropriate budgets
9. Ensure sound doctrine is maintained in all teaching environments in the church
10. Perform other duties as assigned by the Lead Pastor

As an employee of Seymour First Baptist Church, you are an important aspect of the ministry of Christ through this church body, because of this, you must be a model of Christian behavior and morality. You must agree to live a witness of the life of Christ in testimony, behavior, and attitude.
